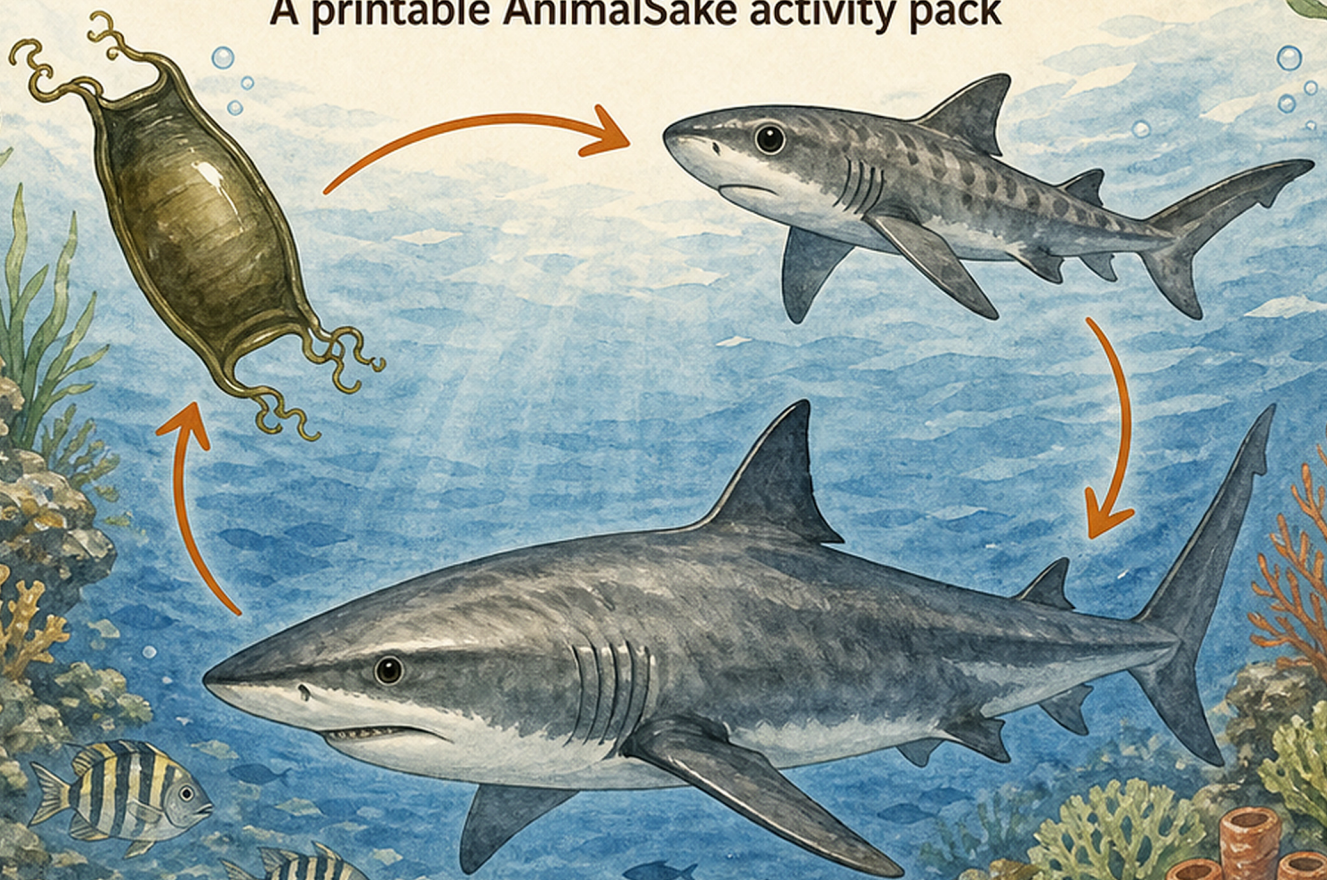

Different sharks begin life in different ways.

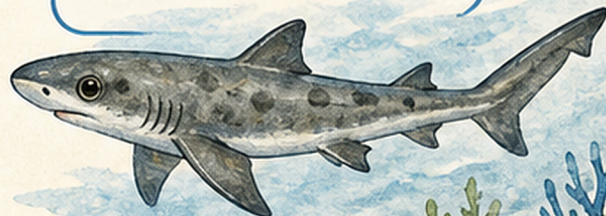
1. Egg or embryo

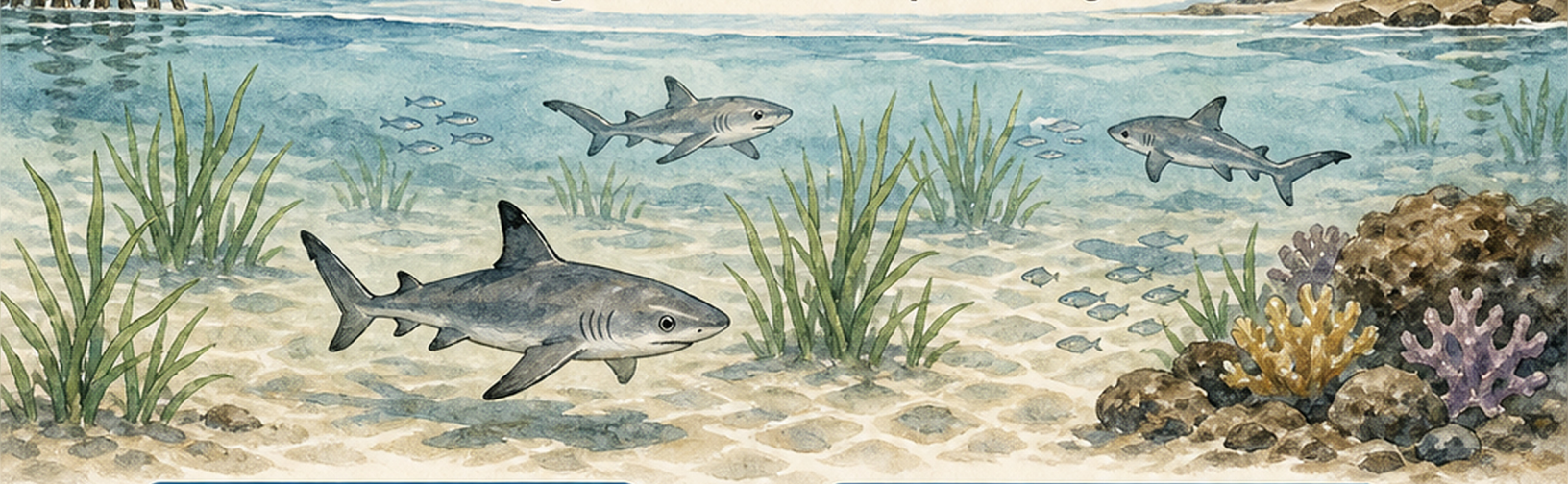

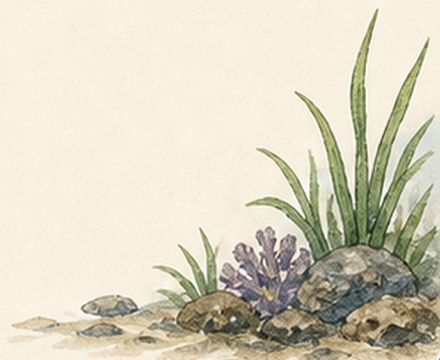
