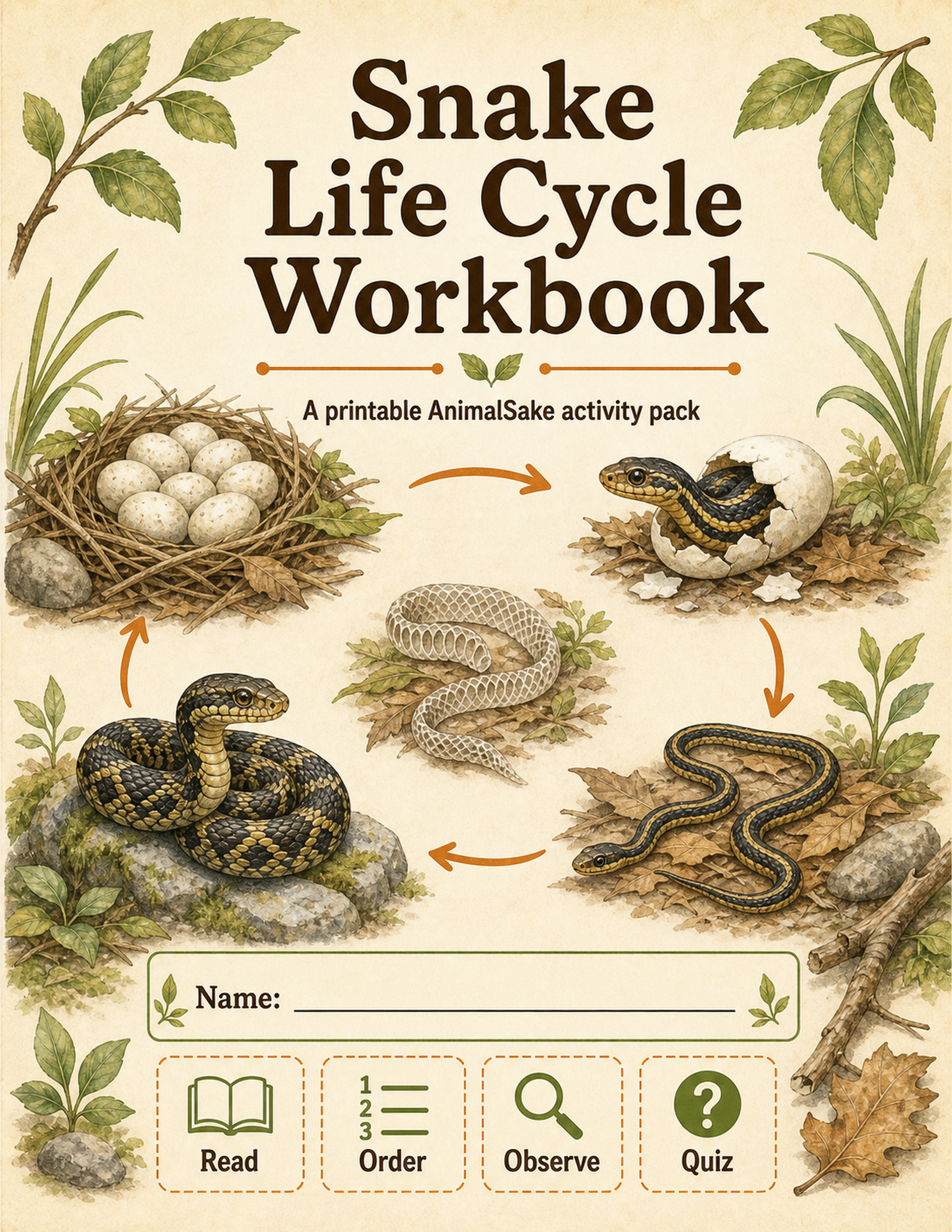

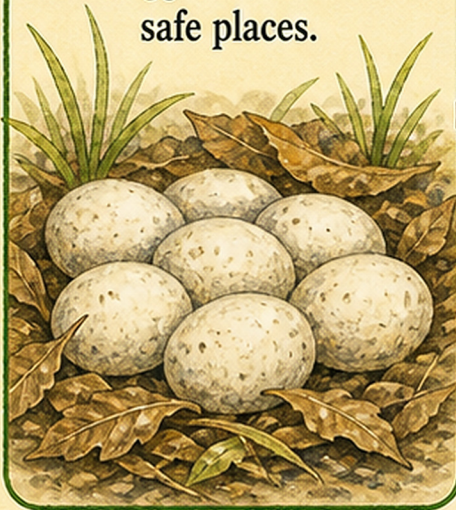

1. Egg

2. Hatchling

A young snake breaks out and begins life on its own.



3. Adult Snake

An adult can hunt, shed skin, and reproduce.

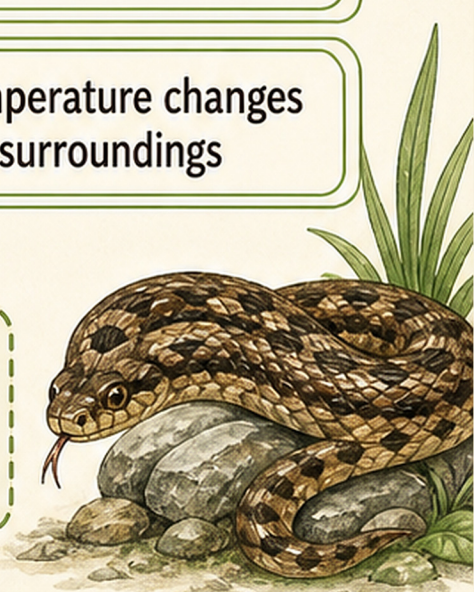

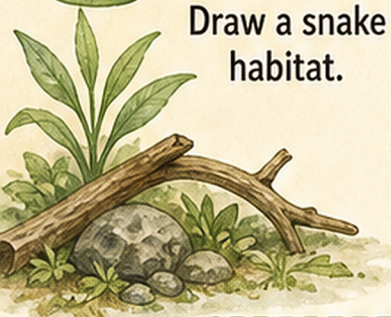
